George Hardy, the last surviving Tuskegee Airmen combat pilot of World War II, died Sept. 23, at 100. At 19, he became the youngest Tuskegee fighter pilot, breaking barriers as one of the first Black military aviators in the U.S. Hardy flew 21 WWII missions and later served in Korea and Vietnam. A lieutenant colonel, he spent his life honoring the Tuskegee legacy and inspiring new generations.
