Seiji Ozawa was a Japanese conductor born on September 1, 1935. He is known internationally for his work as music director of the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, the San Francisco Symphony, and the Boston Symphony Orchestra, where he served from 1973 for 29 years. Among his many international awards and honors, Ozawa received an Emmy, Grammy, and was a Kennedy Center Honoree. Ozawa died at his home in Tokyo, on February 6, 2024. He was 88.
