Lori and George Schappell, the world's oldest living conjoined twins, died on April 7, 2024, in their native Pennsylvania. Joined at the skull at birth with separate bodies, the twins shared 30% of their brain and essential blood vessels, which represents the rarest form of conjoined twinning, affecting only 2-6%. The procedures to separate them via surgery weren't available when they were born.
