Limmie Pulliam, the acclaimed Missouri-born tenor who overcame years of rejection to reclaim his place on the opera stage, died May 20 at 50. In 2022, he made his Metropolitan Opera debut as Radamès in Aida, becoming the first Black tenor to perform the role at the Met.
